



Heating Safety

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Space heaters, fireplaces, and other heating equipment need space and attention.

FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- 1 Keep anything that can burn at least 3 feet away from heating equipment, fireplaces, and space heaters.
- 2 Place portable heaters on a solid, flat surface where they cannot easily tip over.
- 3 Plug space heaters directly into a wall outlet. Do not use an extension cord or power strip.
- 4 Turn portable heaters off before leaving the room or going to sleep.
- 5 Have fireplaces, chimneys, furnaces, and other fuel-burning equipment inspected and maintained as recommended by a qualified professional.

REMEMBER

Never use an oven or stovetop to heat your home.
