



Lithium-Ion Battery Safety

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Rechargeable batteries power many devices, but damaged or overheated batteries can ignite.

FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- 1 Use the charging equipment supplied or recommended by the device manufacturer.
- 2 Stop using a battery if you notice swelling, leaking, unusual odor, excessive heat, color change, or odd noises.
- 3 Keep batteries and charging devices away from beds, couches, paper, clothing, and other combustible materials.
- 4 Do not store batteries in direct sunlight or in a hot vehicle.
- 5 Do not place lithium-ion batteries in household trash. Use an approved battery recycling or collection location.

REMEMBER

If a battery or device starts smoking or burning, move away, call 911, and warn others to stay clear.
